- Explain church language naturally





3. Engagement Tips

- Create a culture of love.
- Use open questions: "What do you think?" and "Why do you think that?"
- Encourage churched youth to mentor others.

- Hebrews 4:12 Power of Scripture
- Galatians 6:1 Restoration in gentleness
- Ephesians 2:10 Identity in Christ
- I Corinthians 12:12 Unity in diversity
